Primary Movement

The children will enjoy participating in these simple action rhymes.

Curriculum Matters

Colours for the month



This month's colours are pink and red. The shape we are focussing on is the heart \P . Please encourage your child to look out for these colours and shape in their environment.

Topic for the month/Shape for the month



The topics for this month are <u>Transport</u> and <u>People Who Help Us</u>. The children can explore the concepts (at a basic level) of push, pull, forces – acceleration, deceleration,

magnets, floating and sinking. This can be encouraged through play areas – magnets, planks, metal and non-metal transport vehicles in sand and water. Try to encourage your child to verbalise why sand slows down vehicles how magnets work etc.



Encourage your child to predict which objects will float/sink. You can play in water with various shaped vegetables, boats, rocks, feathers, balls etc.

It is also a good idea to heighten the children's awareness of people around us who help us.
