Up Jack got and off he trot As fast as he could caper He went to bed to mend his head With vinegar and brown paper.




Twinkle Twinkle Little Star

Baa Baa Black Sheep


Baa baa black sheep Have you any wool? Yes sir, yes sir Three bags full One for the master One for the dame And one for the little boy Who lives down the lane.
