We are looking forward to three more sessions with Mr Hullabaloo: Wednesday 7th, 14th and 21st June.

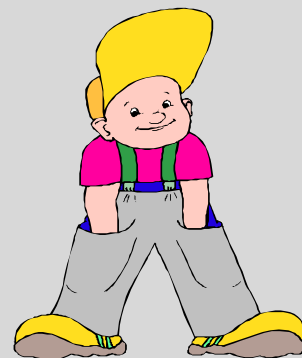
Children's Safety

A text will be sent out in September with details of our Returns Reunion. After that your number will be deleted from the Text Messaging System – keep an eye out for the text!

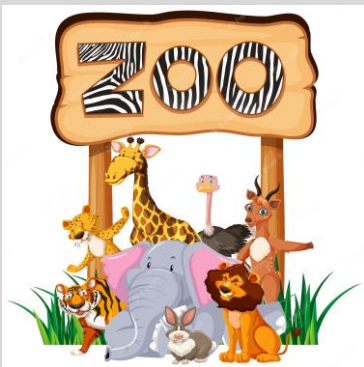
Interest List for younger children

This month's colours are "all colours" (including grey). We will be mixing colours using the primary colours and discussing colours of new primary school uniforms!

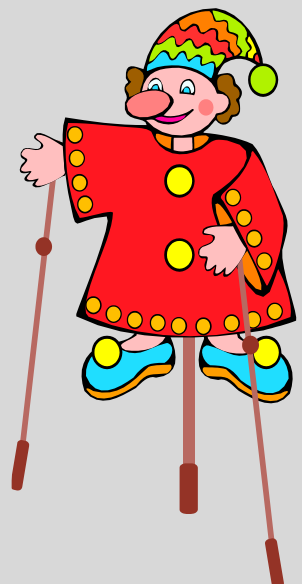
Topics for the month
