#### Bags to be Kept in School

#### **Curriculum Matters**

During the settling-in period in September the six areas of the curriculum will be set up to allow your child ease of achievement and enjoyment. This is to build their selfconfidence and allow them time to build a relationship with the staff.



At the heart of the revised curriculum in Northern Ireland lies an explicit emphasis on the development of skills and capabilities for life-long learning and for operating effectively in society. By developing thinking skills and personal capabilities in nursery school, attention is given to the processes of learning and not just the products; young children naturally engage in active rather than passive learning; these skills help children to go beyond the mere recall of information to develop a deeper understanding of topics; they create positive dispositions and habits for learning; and they also provide a new range of criteria against which children can evaluate their progress in learning.

#### Nut Allergies

Our school is a nut-free zone. We would kindly ask you to ensure your child does not bring <u>any food to school</u>. On children's birthdays the school will provide a treat!

  - meal times using cutlery, sitting at the dinner table.


#### Car Park
